ORDER

As per the reference cited 1st, the Principal, Amal College of Advanced Studies, Nilambur, submitted an application for recognising the Department of English of the College as Research Centre of the University.

Considering the request, the Vice-Chancellor, vide reference cited 2nd, appointed Dr. Shamshad Hussain K. T. (Member of the Syndicate), Dr. Salil Varma R, Associate Professor, Department of English, St. Joseph College, Calicut (Subject Expert) and the Director, Directorate of Research as members of the Research Recognition Committee to inspect and report on the facilities available in the Department of English, Amal College of Advanced Studies, Nilambur to consider the application for recognising it as a Research Centre of the University.


The Committee inspected the Centre and submitted its report vide reference 3rd above, which unanimously recommended to grant recognition to the Department of English, Amal College of Advanced Studies, Nilambur as Research Centre of the University with a suggestion that it would be ideal to shift the research centre to the new Library and Research Complex which is under construction.

The matter has been placed before the Syndicate for consideration. On the basis of the report of the Research Recognition Committee, as per the reference cited 4th above, the Syndicate at its meeting held on 05.09.2022, has resolved to grant recognition to the Department of English, Amal College of Advanced Studies, Nilambur as Research Centre of the University vide item No. 2022.1007*, with the direction detailed in pre-para.

Sanction has been accorded by the Vice-Chancellor, as per the reference cited 5th, to implement the resolution of the Syndicate dated 05.09.2022 vide item No. 2022.1007*, granting recognition to the Department of English, Amal College of Advanced Studies, Nilambur as Research Centre of the University.
