

Introduction

Feedback from the stakeholders are the key element in imparting quality in higher education. Curriculum of the courses taught in a programme should be carefully designed and implemented to ensure high standards. At amal college we have been taking feedback from all stakeholders. Old students are being an integral part of education, we have collected exhaustive feedback from them on curriculum design and implementation.

Methodology of data collection and analysis

We have used a structured Google form questionnaire for collecting responses online from all our teachers at every academic year. Qualitative statements in a five point agreement scale were used to study teachers' feedback. Basic profile analysis and descriptive analysis of alumni feedback for various dimensions of curriculum are done.
